This prospectus supplement (the "**Supplement**") constitutes a second supplement to and must be read in conjunction with the Base Prospectus dated 20 October 2017 established by Danone (the "**Issuer**" or "**Danone**") in relation to its € 16,000,000,000 Euro Medium Term Note Programme (the "**Programme**") which received visa no. 17-563 from the *Autorité des marchés financiers* (the "**AMF**") on 20 October 2017 as supplemented by a prospectus supplement dated 15 March 2018 which received visa no. 18-086 from the AMF on 15 March 2018 (the "**Base Prospectus**"). Terms defined in the Base Prospectus have the same meaning when used in this Supplement.

Application has been made for approval of this Supplement to the AMF in its capacity as competent authority pursuant to Article 212-2 of its *Règlement Général* which implements the Prospectus Directive in France.

This Supplement has been prepared for the purpose of giving information with regard to the Issuer and the Notes to be issued under the Programme additional to the information already contained or incorporated by reference in the Base Prospectus pursuant to Article 16.1 of the Directive 2003/71/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 November 2003 as amended (which includes the amendments made by Directive 2010/73/EU) and Article 212-25 of the AMF General Regulation (*Règlement général de l'AMF*).

To the extent there is any inconsistency between (a) any statement in this Supplement or any statement incorporated by reference into the Base Prospectus by this Supplement, and (b) any other statement in or incorporated by reference in the Base Prospectus, the statements in (a) above will prevail.

Save as disclosed in this Supplement, there has been no other significant new factor, material mistake or inaccuracy relating to information included in the Base Prospectus which is capable of affecting the assessment of Notes issued under the Programme since the publication of the Base Prospectus.

This Supplement has been produced for the purpose of amending and supplementing the following sections of the Base Prospectus:

- Risk Factors;
- Documents Incorporated by Reference; and
- General Information.

The Base Prospectus and this Supplement are available without charge during normal business hours on any weekday at the registered office of the Issuer and the specified office of the paying agent(s) where copies may be obtained. Such documents will be published on the website of (i) *the Autorité des marchés financiers* (www.amf-france.org) and (ii) the Issuer (www.danone.com).

- financial market risks."
